

## Nashville National Golf Links Senior League Rules

1. Senior League will follow golf play rules set forth by USGA unless local course rule supersedes the USGA rule.
  - a. Local Rule #1: All bunkers are considered ground under for the 2021 Senior League Season. Pull ball back to nearest point of relief in the grass
  - b. Off tee the ball goes out of bounds, player can retee from tee box (1 stroke penalty) or drop ball two club lengths into fairway lateral to point of entry and take a two-stroke penalty
  - c. Player may roll their ball 12" left or right where balls lies in play, ball may not be rolled from rough to fairway or out of a hazard
2. Tees for Play:
  - a. Age 55-74 will play from White (Senior) tees
  - b. Age 75+ will play from Yellow (Forward) tees
  - c. Age Under 55 play from Blue (Regular) tees (guests)
3. There will be one official scorecard per group. The second cart in the group will keep an unofficial scorecard. Please verify scores match for each player prior to submitting the official scorecard
  - a. One the official scorecard has been turned in no changes will be allowed to be made
  - b. Official scorecard must be turned into the Pro Shop
4. The maximum score on each hole is double par. Once double par is reached, pick up ball and move to next hole
  - a. The maximum handicap shall be 36
5. Every effort will be made to allow carts on the fairways, however, occasionally Cart Path Only rule will need to be enforced
6. Please repair divot and ball marks on greens
7. Please keep pace with the group ahead and play Ready Golf
